



 **Flashpoint 13 Infinity**

Size: 1.9MB download, ~1.9 - 3.5GB when installed

Entries are downloaded from our servers when you play them. Ideal for casual users.

Installation size depends on chosen components, and increases as you download entries.

Download and install the Flashpoint 13 Infinity Installer and install.

Go to the folder *C:\Flashpoint\FPSoftware\Shockwave\PJ9* and make sure you have the program *Projector.exe*.

Select a flashwave file (ends with *.dcr*). Right click and choose “*Open With*”.

Navigate to the above folder and choose the program *Projector.exe* to open.

Make this the default choice for *.dcr* files.
