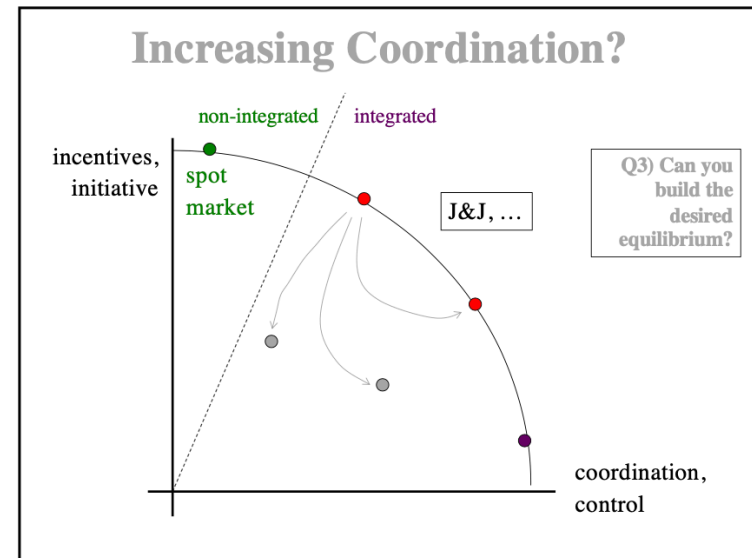
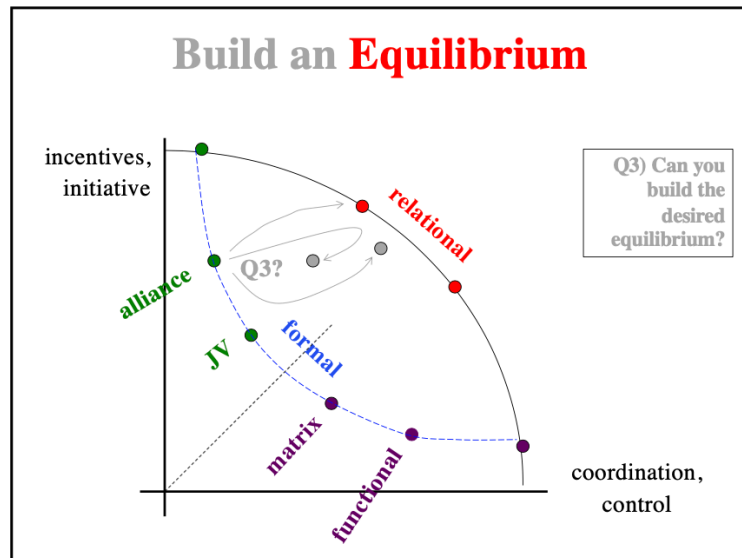
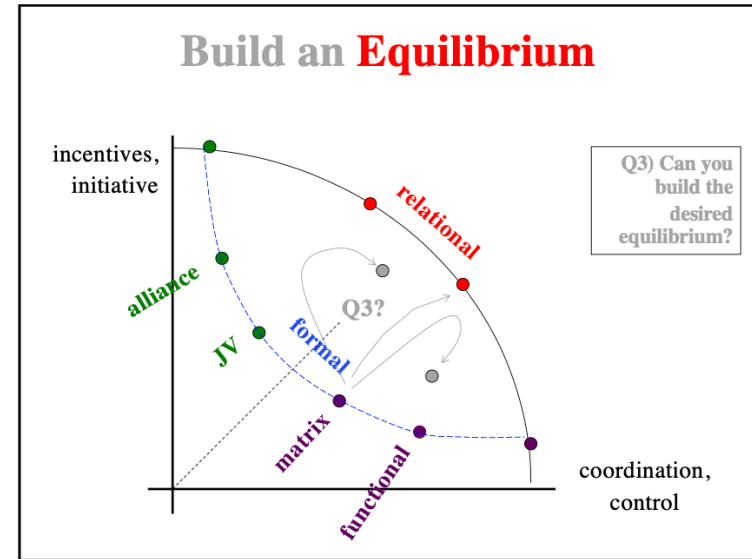
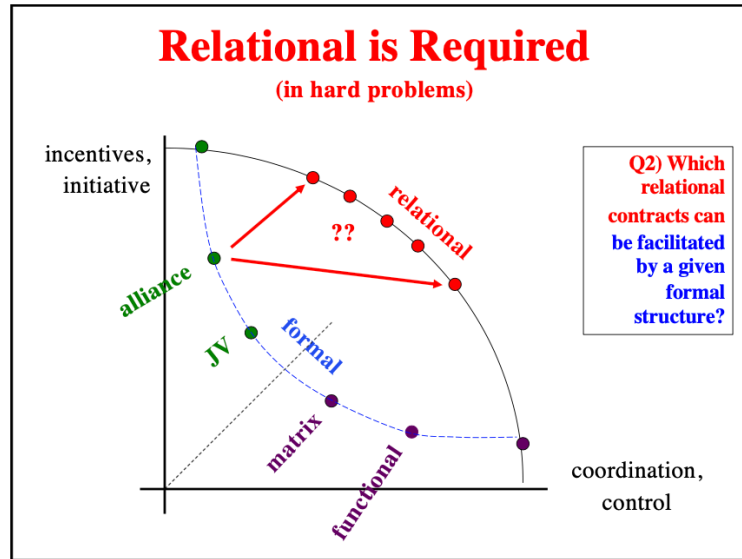


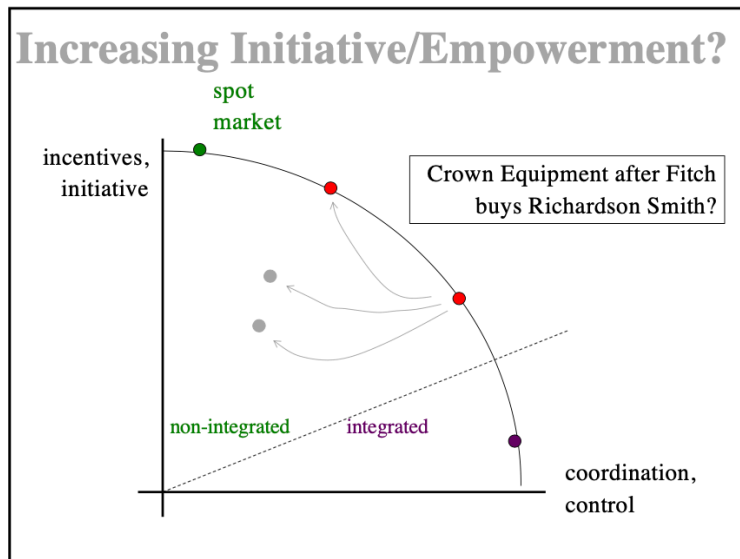
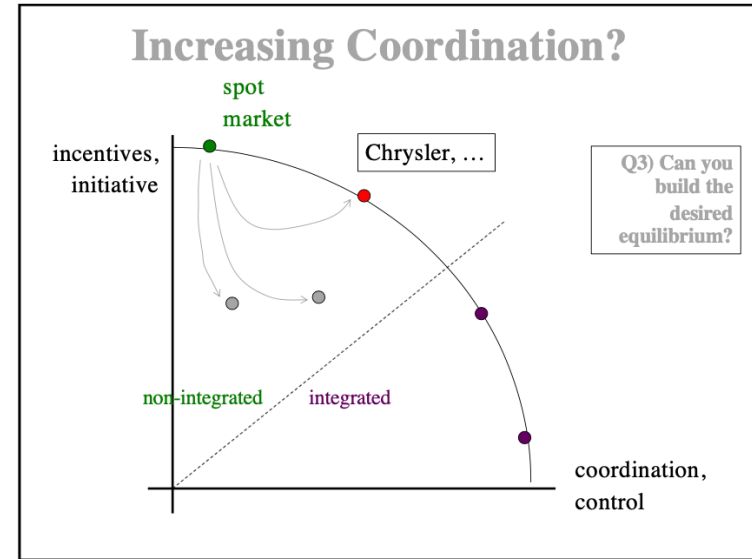
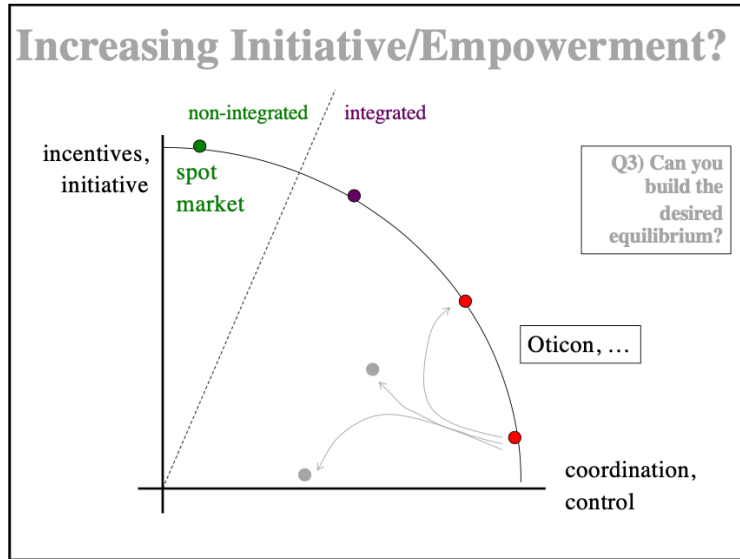












### Many Formal Governance Structures
